Subject: UDAG Summary

I am delivering, per request, Urban Development Action Grants (UDAG) summary report for your perusal. The current UDAG process is provided to inform the applicant of the various steps included in receiving any funding from the UDAG program. Each project is unique, special circumstances may arise.

The UDAG funds were made available to cities and urban counties experiencing severe economic distress to help stimulate economic development activity needed to aid in economic recovery. The funds are normally used for economic development activities which generally assist industrial, commercial and housing projects where stimulation of private investment is needed.

### **UDAG Eligible Activities:**

Generally, UDAG funds may assist industrial, commercial and housing projects where there is private investment. The following is a list of eligible activities:

- a. construction/permanent financing
- b. affixed capital equipment
- c. land acquisition
- d. parking facilities
- e. infrastructure
- f. interim expenses including interest, taxes, insurance
- g. hard cost, including building construction, rehabilitation
- h. professional fees, tenant improvements and finishes, legal, accounting, leasing

#### **UDAG Ineligible Activities:**

The following activities are ineligible under the UDAG program, principally because program policy does not permit the use of UDAG funds for these activities:

- a. working capital and inventory
- b. research and development activities
- c. payment of prior debt
- d. educational facilities
- e. gambling facilities, except on Indian reservations
- f. free standing parking facility as the only project activity
- g. non-capital equipment (i.e., hand tools, office equipment)
- h. reserve fund for operating deficit, debt service or interest reserve
- i. acquisition of existing assets without additional private development activity
- j. rolling stock (i.e., railroad cars or boats not permanently moored, cars, moveable heavy equipment)


