

Over-View of Jail Population Projections Study

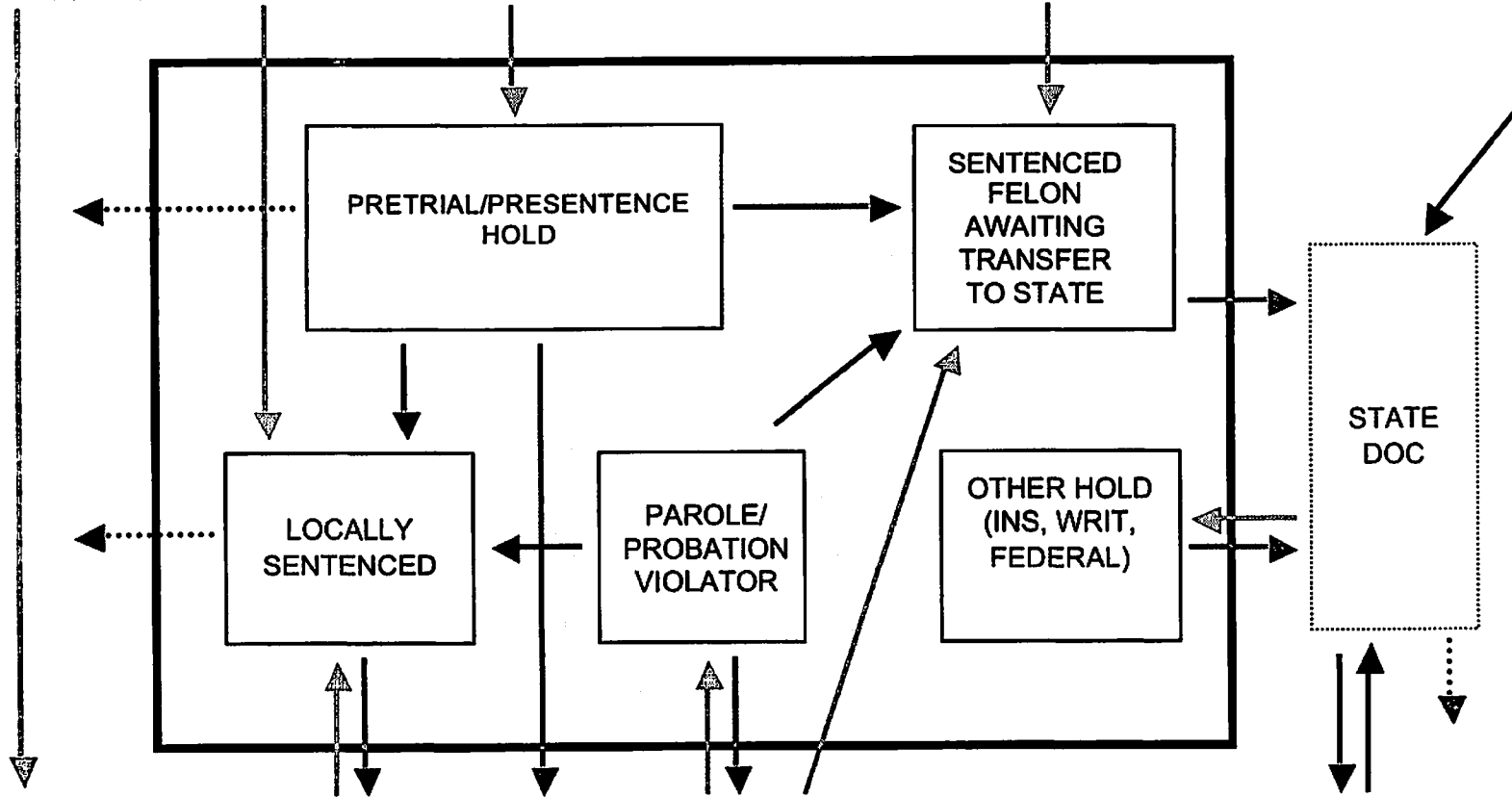
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Over-View

1. Develop projection simulation model to estimate current and alternative policies
2. Collect detailed data on demographics, crime rate, arrest, jail admission, and jail release trends
3. Issue “baseline” projection and report by November 2, 2010
4. Conduct simulations of alternative policies
 - Changes in state housed inmates
 - Implementation of pretrial services agency
 - Alternate police arrest practices
 - Others that may be requested
5. Provide training of staff on projection model/techniques

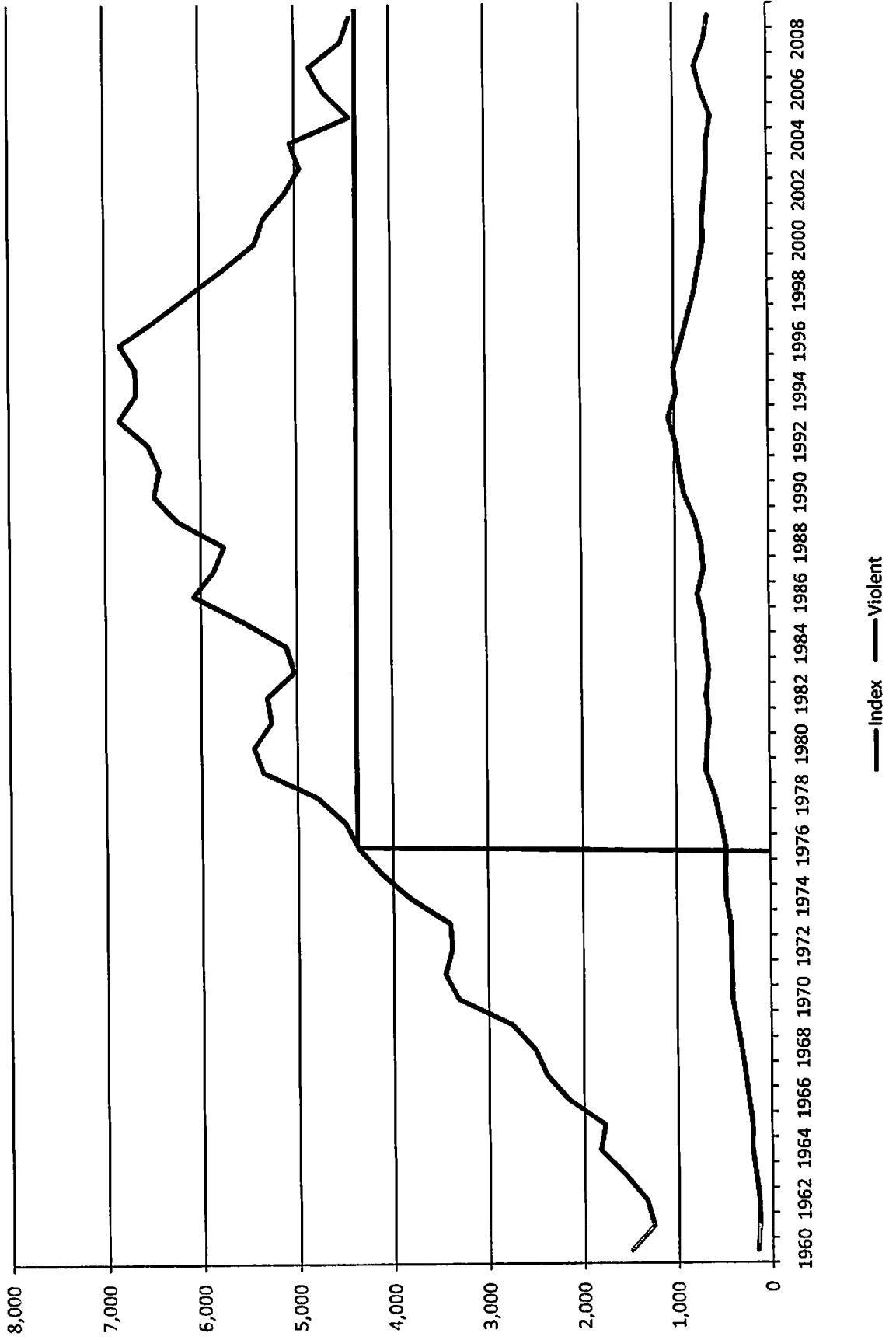


COMMUNITY SUPERVISION and COMMUNITY-BASED FACILITIES

Louisiana Crime Rates

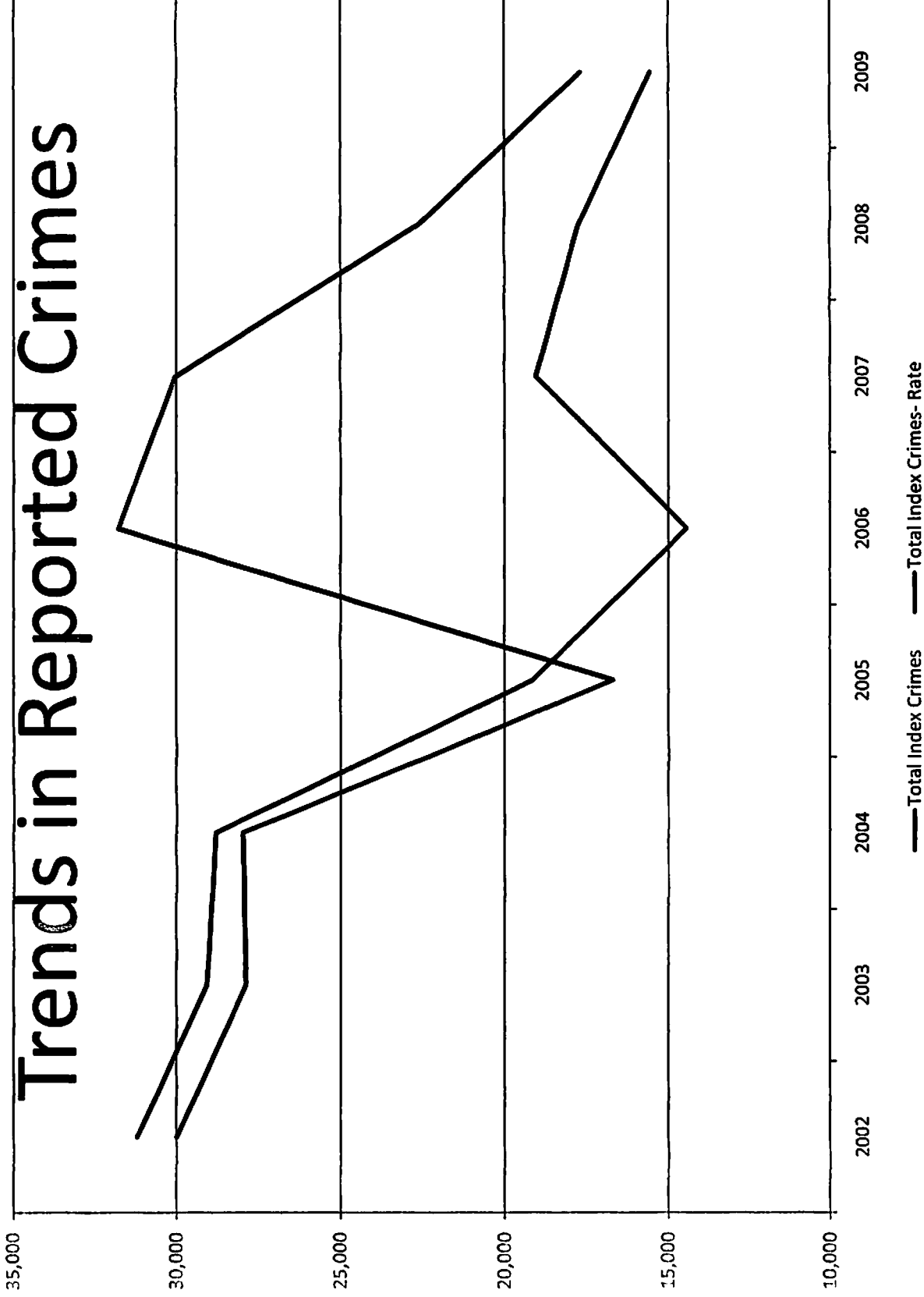

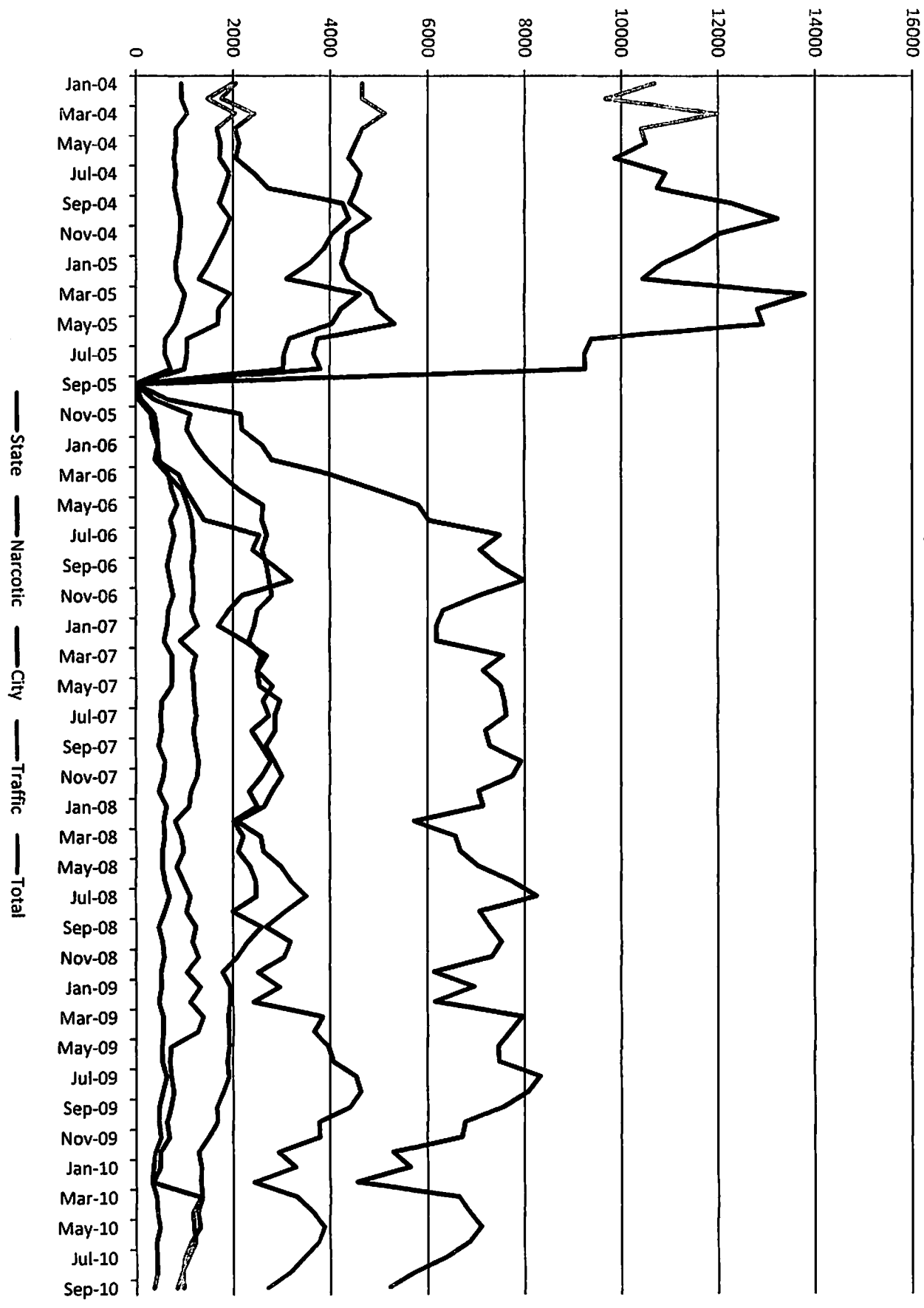

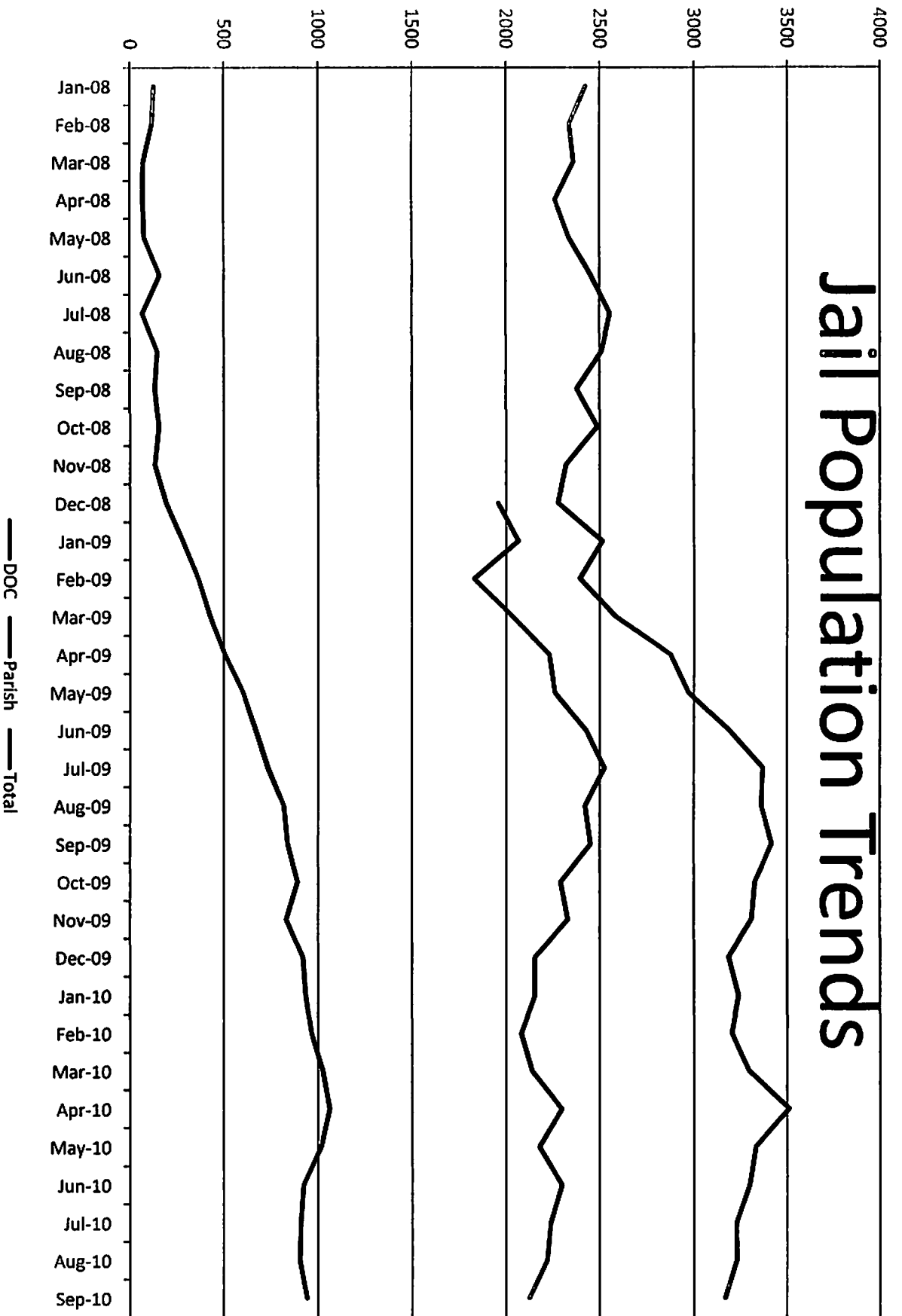

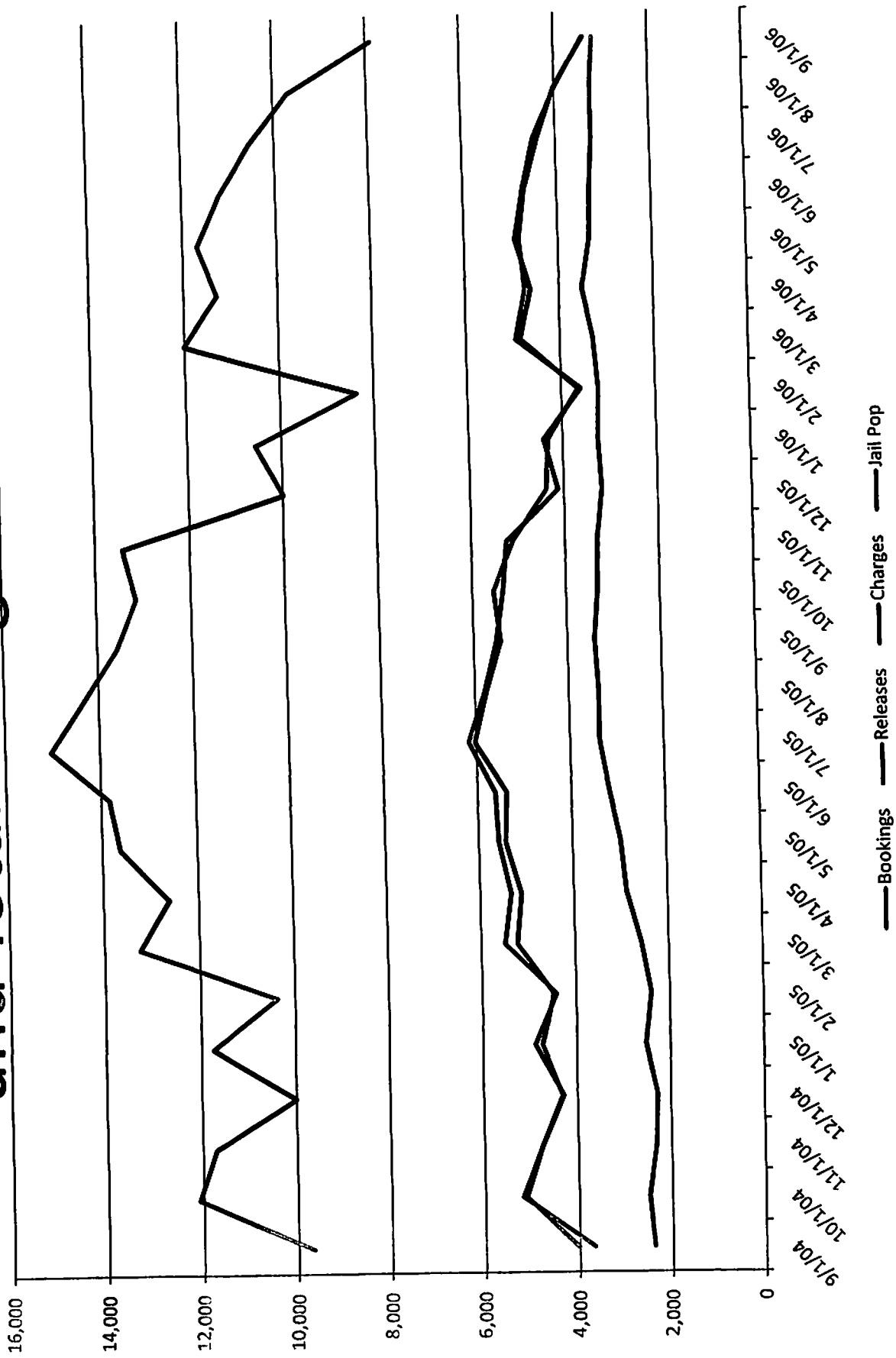
Orleans Adult Arrest Trends

Summary

1. Demographics are stable
2. Crime rates are trending down
3. Arrests are trending down
4. Bookings are trending down
5. Jail population is flat
6. The largest groups in the jail at any time are (a) state DOC, (b) pretrial felony and (c) pretrial misdemeanors
7. At this point no indication that the Parish portion of the jail population will increase
8. Several reforms are being suggested that would lower the Parish portion of the jail population
9. Controlling for reported serious crime rates, Orleans has a significantly higher jail incarceration rate than other Parishes.
