DATE: June 9, 2011

The Office of Community Development is providing the requested information concerning the current balance of encumbered and unencumbered NHIF, HOME and CDBG allocations in anticipation of the June 20, 2011 Housing Committee meeting.

The 2011 budget approved on Dec. 1, 2010 was a projection based on the funding received in 2010. However, HUD has provided OCD with preliminary allocations that reduce the CDBG and HOME 2011 funding.

The HOME budget will require a reduction from \$10,788,391 to \$10,710,748. OCD's 2011 HOME NOFA based on the place based strategy will provide \$9,000,000 in available funding for homebuyer, rental housing and owner occupied rehab programs.

The 2011 CDBG budget will require a reduction from \$31,926,981 to \$28,898,578. Additional reductions will result in an unencumbered amount of \$15,608,983. OCD is committed to providing funding for the following projects in 2011:

•Streets resurfacing-DPW \$7,515,646 •NORD Summer Programs \$1,862,712 •Public Facilities Improvements \$1,200,000 •Demolition Program \$3,754,842 •Minority Contractor Training Program \$834,147

The NHIF program has a total of \$4,633,694 unencumbered. There have been no encumbrances of NHIF. Until the Neighborhood Housing Improvement Advisory Committee is created, there will be no movement on projects for this funding source. Once the committee is in place, projects associated with providing homeownership opportunities, rental opportunities for low and moderate income persons and the elimination of blight will be the focus.

Attached is a spreadsheet that delineates the aforementioned information. In addition, attached are spreadsheets on all of the existing programs with encumbrances. The majority of the funding is for projects encumbered prior to 2011.
