Students

- -Exams begin next week for students in grades 1-8. Schedules and study guides are being sent home this week.
- -4th Quarter PBS is scheduled May 13th. We have rented 5 inflatables for students who earn a 90 or above to enjoy.
- -Awards for students in grades 1-7 are on May 15th.
- -Kindergarten Closing Program is on May 17th at 8:30 AM and at 8AM for PreK.
- -8th grade graduation is scheduled for May 24, 2013 at 9AM. Invitations to Board Members will be mailed.
- -LEAP results will be downloaded on Friday, May 17th.
- -The students have been involved in field days sponsored by our PE department.
- -Hynes students are participating in Field testing during the week of May 6th.

Administration/Teachers

- -Hynes is advertising for vacant positions on the Eastbank Collaborative's vacancy site. Hynes was represented at the city-wide teacher fair (co-sponsored by the Eastbank Collaborative and LAPSCA) at Xavier University on Saturday, April 27th.
- -Day 2 of Kagan Training is scheduled for Tuesday, May 21st. This is funded through our Title II allocation.
- -We have very few evaluations to complete to finalize our rosters for COMPASS.
- -We have completed our roster verifications for teachers thorough the CVR.

Operations

- -We have received training on the Siemens automated system and the Video Viewer for the surveillance cameras. These were two open items on the punch list.
- Entergy bill in March/April was \$9,000.

Family & Community Involvement

- The PTO hosted the Peace, Love and Hynes Fair and Fun Run on Saturday, April 20th. The event was well-supported by the school's community.
- JA for the Day is Tuesday, April 20, 2013 for grades K-5. The LCPA and Councilmember Guidry's office will be here to extend a City of NO Proclamation for this program.
- -Rep. Larusso (LA Dist. 94) will host Hynes 4th graders in Baton Rouge on Monday, May 6th. They will have a tour, visit the legislature, and be treated to an ice cream on the steps of the Capitol.
- -On May 6th at 3PM, Rosalind Wiseman (author of *Queen Bees and Wanna Bees*) will visit with Hynes Alumni who helped her with the boy version of this book.

Academic

- -Hynes will host a summer program for targeted students from June 3-June 14. It will be funded through Title I.
- -End of the year and quarter assessments are scheduled and taking place. Teachers are collecting their SLT data to complete their observation cycle.
